Raju Kumar is a Bhopal-based journalist, currently working as Principal Correspondent (Madhya Pradesh) at The Sunday Indian. For the last 12 years, he has written extensively on rural development and other social issues; he has also covered assembly elections in the state since 2005.

"It is 27 years since one of the world's worst industrial accidents, the Bhopal Gas Tragedy occurred and the wounds of those affected are yet to be healed. In the last decade, two of the hospitals run for gas victims have opened DOTS centres. Based on research by ICMR, a separate pulmonary medicine centre was also opened. Significantly 15% of the expectorant samples tested positive for the TB bacteria."
